

### SIDA Recurrent READ & INITIAL Statement

I hereby agree to the following Burlington International Airport (Airport Operations Division) Security directives and provisions stated: **please read and initial all statements**

- \_\_\_\_\_ **1.** I agree to comply at all times with the security rules and policies of the airport operator, including the provisions of Chapter 25 and the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), an agency of the United States, including the provisions of Title 49, CFR Parts 1540, 1542, and 1544.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **2.** My ID badge remains the property of the Burlington International Airport (BTV) and is issued for use as long I have an operational need for unescorted access, and is not transferable to any other individual. BTV Operations has the right to revoke the authorization of my ID badge where such action is determined to be in the best interest of airport security.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **3.** I will visibly display my ID badge on the outer most garment, above the waist at all times when inside the SIDA, Secure, or Sterile areas of the airport.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **4.** I must challenge individuals who are not displaying airport approved identification and immediately notify the Airport Operations or TSA of any individual with an invalid ID, or who cannot produce a valid airport issued or airport approved ID
- \_\_\_\_\_ **5.** In the event of any change in my SIDA Badge Status, I will obtain a new ID badge and/or return my current badge.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **6.** I will not aid nor participate in **“piggy backing” (allowing unauthorized access to secure or restricted areas)** nor will I otherwise breach, disobey, or disregard any security directive, plan, or program at the airport. Failure to comply with BTV Security Rules shall result in badge suspension and possible revocation.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **7.** I will immediately notify my Authorized Signatory who will then inform the Airport Operations if I am arrested of any crimes listed under Title 49, CRF, Parts 1542.209 and 1544.229
- \_\_\_\_\_ **8.** I will immediately notify my Authorized Signatory and Airport Operations if my ID badge is lost or stolen. I understand that I am able to receive a replacement badge when I pay the fee (\$100.00) and fill out a lost badge form.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **9.** I understand that if I am found in violation of any of the proceeding statements, I am liable to have my BTV ID revoked, suspended, or terminated. I also fully understand I can be accountable for up to (\$10,000) in TSA fines.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **10.** I have been given the opportunity to read the Privacy Act Statement regarding the use of my biographical information fingerprints and associated information/biometrics. I have been given a copy of the Privacy Act Statement if I requested one.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **11.** If I have escort authority, I understand my responsibilities under the Airport Security Plan.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **12.** I understand that my SIDA badge may only be used for the purpose for which it was issued. This means Official Business Only, unless otherwise authorized by the Airport Security Coordinator.

## **TSA Privacy Act Statement**

**Authority:** 6 U.S.C. § 1140, 46 U.S.C. § 70105; 49 U.S.C. §§ 106, 114, 5103a, 40103(b)(3), 40113, 44903, 44935-44936, 44939, and 46105; the Implementing Recommendations of the 9/11 Commission Act of 2007, § 1520 (121 Stat. 444, Public Law 110-53, August 3, 2007); FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018, §1934(c) (132 Stat. 3186, Public Law 115-254, Oct 5, 2018), and Executive Order 9397 (November 22, 1943), as amended.

**Purpose:** The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) will use the information to conduct a security threat assessment. If applicable, your fingerprints and associated information will be provided to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for the purpose of comparing your fingerprints to other fingerprints in the FBI's Next Generation Identification (NGI) system or its successor systems including civil, criminal, and latent fingerprint repositories. **The FBI may retain your fingerprints and associated information in NGI after the completion of this application and, while retained, your fingerprints may continue to be compared against other fingerprints submitted to or retained by NGI.** DHS will also transmit your fingerprints for enrollment into US-VISIT Automated Biometrics Identification System (IDENT).

DHS will also maintain a national, centralized revocation database of individuals who have had airport or aircraft operator-issued identification media revoked for noncompliance with aviation security requirements. DHS has established a process to allow an individual whose name is mistakenly entered into the database to correct the record and have the individual's name expunged from the database. If an individual who is listed in the centralized database wishes to pursue expungement due to mistaken identity, the individual must send an email to TSA at [Aviation.workers@tsa.dhs.gov](mailto:Aviation.workers@tsa.dhs.gov).

**Routine Uses:** In addition to those disclosures generally permitted under 5 U.S.C. § 552a(b) of the Privacy Act, all or a portion of the records or information contained in this system may be disclosed outside DHS as a routine use pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552a(b)(3) including with third parties during the course of a security threat assessment, employment investigation, or adjudication of a waiver or appeal request to the extent necessary to obtain information pertinent to the assessment, investigation, or adjudication of your application or in accordance with the routine uses identified in the TSA system of records notice (SORN) DHS/TSA 002, Transportation Security Threat Assessment System. For as long as your fingerprints and associated information are retained in NGI, your information may be disclosed pursuant to your consent or without your consent as permitted by the Privacy Act of 1974 and all applicable Routine Uses as may be published at any time in the Federal Register, including the Routine Uses for the NGI system and the FBI's Blanket Routine Uses.

**Disclosure:** Pursuant to § 1934(c) of the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018, TSA is required to collect your SSN on applications for Secure Identification Display Area (SIDA) credentials. For SIDA applications, failure to provide this information will result in denial of a credential. For other aviation credentials, although furnishing your SSN is voluntary, if you do not provide the information requested, DHS may be unable to complete your security threat assessment.
